







Photographic record of a walk around the perimeter of Manhattan Ring-bound book sans beginning or end, 90 laminated SX 70 Polaroid prints Raised type title and artist's name, 6 x 6 x 2 inches Collection of the artist

Facing North the camera was focused on the farthest visible point of land extending into water, a picture was taken and the artist walked to that point; pivoting 180° the last point of departure was photographed; repeating the process the island was circumnavigated in three days.





paired on opposing pages with one of the pairs treated with liver of sulfur.




















