Pure salt of the Earth

Dove Bradshaw's latest sculptures are never static. In "Six Continents," mounds of salt have been poured on the floor while a glass funnel from above drops water onto the mass below, changing the composition of the work with each drip. The piece uses 100 pounds of salt from each of six continents. As the minerals from each region react differently to water, they create various colors and crystallizations. Paintings and photographic works will also be on display.
